About the Position

These could include: violence, gender, ethnicity, politics, international diplomacy, sociology, education, the environment, medicine, immigration, organizational psychology, management, spirituality and religion, philosophy, anthropology, physics and the arts (including music, drawing, painting, sculpture, prose, poetry, film and theater).

Applications from candidates from underrepresented groups are especially welcome.

The role involves reviewing three to four papers a year. The process involves reviewing submissions to the journal in your area of expertise, as assigned by the Manuscript Review Editor, making constructive comments to improve the manuscript, and returning a recommendation to the Editor-in-Chief within a timeframe of 3 to 4 weeks.
